

**Announcement:
Treatment Services Solicitation No. TS-PPSO-2021
Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts,
Procurement Management Division**

The federal judiciary, via the Chief Probation Officer for the U.S. District Court, Southern District of Iowa, intends to procure substance abuse testing and/or treatment services and mental health services for federal defendants and offenders using Blanket Purchase Agreements. Solicitations of Blanket Purchase Agreements will be issued by the Southern District of Iowa. Required services may include urine collection, substance abuse evaluations/assessments, outpatient individual counseling, group substance abuse counseling and mental health counseling.

Interested vendors must contact the Chief U.S. Probation Officer for the Southern District of Iowa, through the Chief's designated officer as indicated below, by responding on time, and must clearly show that (1) their capability to provide requested services, (2) that such services will be provided by certified, licensed professionals with experience in such treatment, and (3) prices of such treatment or urine collection services shall be as low or lower than those charged by the vendor's most favored customer for comparable quantities under similar terms and conditions.

INTERESTED TREATMENT PROVIDERS MUST CONTACT THE FOLLOWING UNITED STATES PROBATION PERSONNEL WITHIN 30 DAYS FROM THE DATE OF THE ANNOUNCEMENT FOR A COPY OF THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL (RFP).
